This Easter season, rejoice that Jesus continues to lead us on. He goes before us and draws us into life.

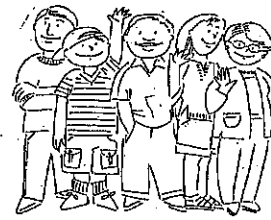
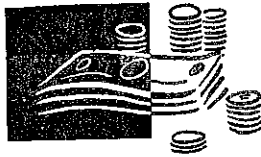

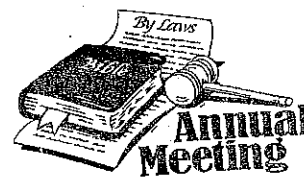
**VERGE YOUTH GROUP NEWS**

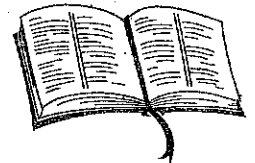
**CHURCH MICE STAMPERS**

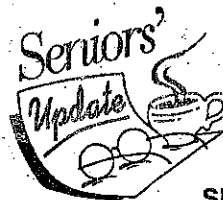
**BOOK CLUB**

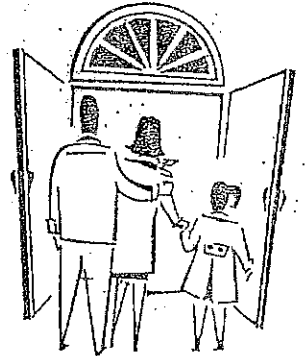

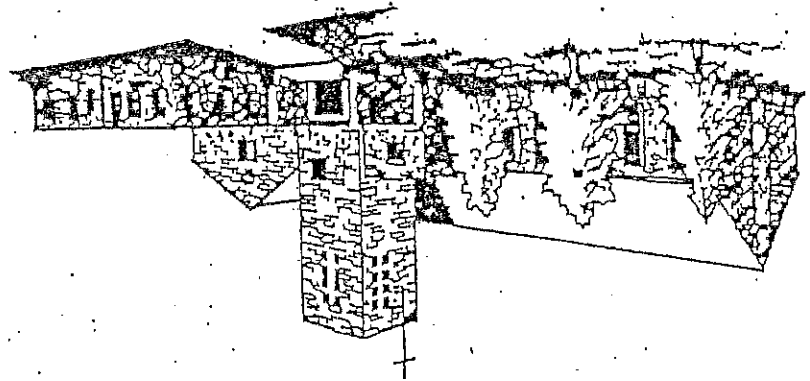
